JOB GOAL: Responsible for planning and supervising a developmentally appropriate childcare program.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assists the Wrap-Around Program Supervisor in the organization, coordination and plans for the building-based wraparound programs.
- 2. Assists the Wrap-Around Program Supervisor in the selection of instructional supplies and equipment.
- 3. Responsible for daily operations at program sites.
- 4. Coordinate planning and implementation of daily program, including all activities.
- 5. Provide leadership and supervision to childcare staff and children at all times; serving as a positive role model.
- 6. Plan, implement and supervise a developmentally and academically appropriate program that meets the social, emotional and behavioral needs of the children.
- 7. Maintain an organized, clean and safe learning and recreational environment for the building.
- 8. Assist the Wrap-Around Program Supervisor to develop and maintain monthly calendar of activities for distribution to parents.
- 9. Supervise all childcare staff, adhere to and enforce Wall Township Board of Education policies and procedures and New Jersey regulations and ensure safety and age appropriateness of all activities.
- 10. Develop and consistently maintain appropriate and professional communication with parents.
- 11. Maintain accurate daily attendance sheets.
- 12. Maintain accurate weekly record of information & log book.
- 13. Manage and control inventory of equipment and supplies.
- 14. Ensure parental compliance with daily sign-in/sign-out sheets.
- 15. Address any behavior and health related issues that arise and inform Wrap-Around Program Supervisor of any instances.
- 16. Ensure staff is maintaining a healthy and supportive environment for students.
- 17. Communicate with school personnel to ensure a positive working relationship.
- 18. Work extra hours in an emergency situation.
- 19. Report all relevant information to the Wrap-Around Program Supervisor in a timely fashion.
- 20. Complete accident, injury, and behavior reports when necessary.
- 21. Participate in the orientation new staff members.
- 22. Obtain and maintain current first aid, CPR, AED, and epi-pen certification.
- 23. Keep a consistent head count on all children present at site; communicate changes with all other staff.
- 24. Perform other duties as requested by the Wrap-Around Program Supervisor or Director of Curriculum & Instruction.
