Grades K – 5 School Bus Information

We thank all students and parents for partnering with us for the safety and well-being of all students, by reviewing the below information and remembering the importance of proper behavior while riding on a school bus:

1. Students should be at the bus stop 10 minutes before the bus is due to arrive.
2. Please be careful on your way to the bus stop. Walk on the sidewalk or on the left side of the road facing oncoming traffic when there are no sidewalks.
3. Students are to look both ways when crossing the street and always cross in front of the school bus.
4. Please go directly to your seat without stopping to talk to other students on the bus.
5. All students will have assigned seats. Once seated, please fasten your seatbelt.
6. The center aisle must always be clear. Do not place bags, books, or lunch boxes in the center isles.
7. Remain seated while on the bus, except when getting on and off, or when the bus driver asks you to change seats.
8. Always keep your head, arms, and hands inside the bus. Projecting any part of the body or any object out of a bus window is very dangerous, and is not allowed.
9. Sorry, but students are not allowed to eat or drink while on the school bus.
10. It is very important that you follow the directions of the bus driver and do what they say. Driving a school bus is a huge responsibility and the drivers need your help.
11. When exiting the bus always cross in front of the bus, and remember to look both ways. Never cross the street behind the school bus.
12. All students are expected to board and depart buses, only at their designated stops, unless temporary permission, in writing, has been granted by the building principal.

Please remember that students are asked to be courteous to the bus driver and other students. Please avoid shouting, and talking too loudly, as loud noises may be distracting to the bus driver or the other students on the bus.
