Wall Intermediate & High School Bus Information

We thank all students and parents for partnering with us for the safety and well-being of all students by reviewing this information and remembering the importance of proper behavior when on the school bus.

Bus Regulations:

The following regulations apply to all students riding the school bus:

1. The school bus driver represents an extension of the authority of the school and is responsible for and in charge of the bus and its passengers.
2. Please assist the driver with this responsibility by practicing good behavior while on the bus.
3. All students will have assigned seats and are to remain seated while on the bus.
4. Students must only ride their assigned bus unless permission has been granted by the school administration. Parents must contact the school by phone or written note requesting permission to ride an alternate school bus prior to 12:15 p.m. of the school day (or by 10:15 a.m. on early dismissal days) so that if approved, proper arrangements may be made.
5. Students are prohibited from making electronic recordings on school vehicles.

Bus Transportation:

The following buses are provided for students who remain after school for:

1st Late Bus (4:00 p.m. Intermediate and High School)

- Extra Help
- Detention (Teacher & Central)
- Scheduled Supervised Student Activities
- Intramurals

2nd Late Bus (5:00 p.m. Intermediate School & 5:15 p.m. High School)

- Inter-Scholastic Athletics (Practice & Games)
- Extended Central Detention
- Scheduled Supervised Student Activities

Disciplinary Procedure for School Bus:

The following disciplinary procedures have been approved to govern the general conduct of all pupils transported to school.

1. At the first sign of misconduct, there will be a verbal warning given by the bus driver.
2. If misconduct continues, a “Student Conduct Report” will be made out by the bus driver and submitted to the Assistant Principal and to the Transportation Supervisor for discipline.
3. The Assistant Principal may contact the parents and ask for their cooperation and will administer appropriate discipline.
4. If misconduct continues, the bus driver will again inform the Assistant Principal and the Transportation Supervisor by a “Student Conduct Report” and more progressive discipline will be administered, including denial of student transportation services as appropriate.
