A "Special Education Parent Advisory Group (SEPAG) is a state-mandated, district-level, parent-driven group charged with providing input to the local school district on system-level challenges in special education and related services." ~ SPAN

Any Wall Township parent/guardian that has a child with an IEP or 504, is enrolled in the Wall Township school district, or home school district is in Wall Township but currently attends an out-of-district school. Parents are the core members of Wall SEPAG. Members may also include Child Study Team members and teachers.
