Care stations staffed with District and Mental Health Association (MHA) counselors will be available at Wall High School today (11/9) and tomorrow (11/10). The schedule is as follows:

Today, Thursday, November 9:

Wall High School: Media Center, entry through the main entrance,

Sessions: 1:30 PM, 2:30 PM, and 3:30 PM

Tomorrow, Friday, November 10:

Wall High School: Media Center, entry through the main entrance,

Sessions: 11:00 AM, 12:00 noon, and 1:00 PM

Loss of life is a difficult issue for everyone. Your needs, our students' needs, and the needs of the Class of 2023 are our priorities as we support the navigation of a painful time for the entire school community.
